Education

Students follow the curriculum and they can have extra-curricular activities. The school year starts on the first of September and ends on the thirties of May. There are two terms in the school year. Students learn different subjects: Economics, English Literature, Science, Ukrainian and others. We solve equations at Maths and write up the experiments at Science. We learn the new words, take the tests, read different texts and discuss them at the English lessons. After the 9-th form the students have the internal exams at school and after the 11-th form they have GCSEs. If they pass the exams the students can enter the university or the institute. The students can choose the different faculties: Economics, Psychology, Social Science, Sociology, Linguistics, Law, Humanities and Science.
